

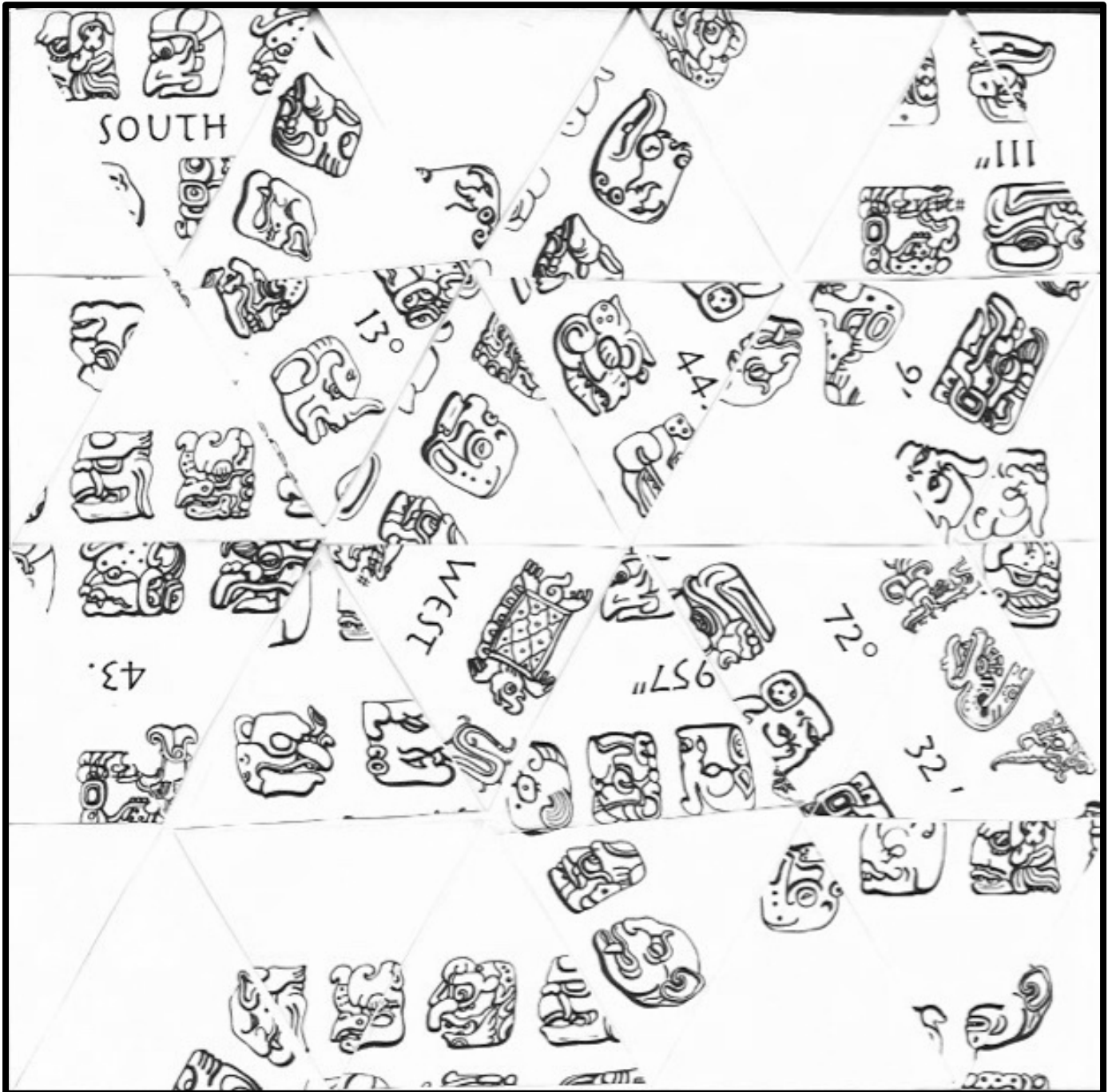
## Part 2
